Prep Classes for CCO Mobile Crane Operator Certification

Includes practical exams: 5-day course or 3-day refresher

Our course is specifically designed for new candidates as Telescopic Boom-Swing Cab and Telescopic Boom Fixed Cab Crane Operators seeking CCO certification. (5-day)

Our refresher course is for operators who already have a CCO certification and are seeking to renew. (3-day)

Prep Class for Certified Rigger Level 1

Includes practical exams: 4-day course or 2-day refresher

NCCCO identified the following job duties for Rigger Level I certification. A Certified Rigger Level I can perform simple, repetitive rigging tasks when the load weight, center of gravity, the rigging, and rigging configuration are provided or known by the rigger through experience or on-the-job training prior to the rigging activities.

Specifically, Level I Riggers should be able to demonstrate or have knowledge of how to:

- Inspect rigging before use
- Identify, select, and attach rigging with basic knowledge of hitch configurations, capacities, and basic knots
- Recognize associated hazards
- Use various types of rigging equipment and basic hitches and their applications

2-day refresher course is for candidates who need to renew their Rigger Level 1 certification

Prep Class for Certified Signalperson

Includes practical exams: 4-day course or 2-day refresher

This class is for any site worker tasked with the responsibility to communicate with the operator of any load-moving apparatus. Signalpersons act as the eyes and ears for the crane operator, directing what actions need to be carried out.
